Consultation

- To ascertain any accommodations, the student might require on college grounds and to comprehend the effects of a handicap student.
- The consultation entails: To learn more about the support required on the college campus, speak with the student's parents, guardians, or other caregivers. - A discussion to determine whether the accommodations on the college campus are pleasant or not. - Providing pertinent medical records that describe the disability and the requirements and helpful supports - A meeting to inspect the setup on the college campus.

Make comfortable arrangements within the college premises
